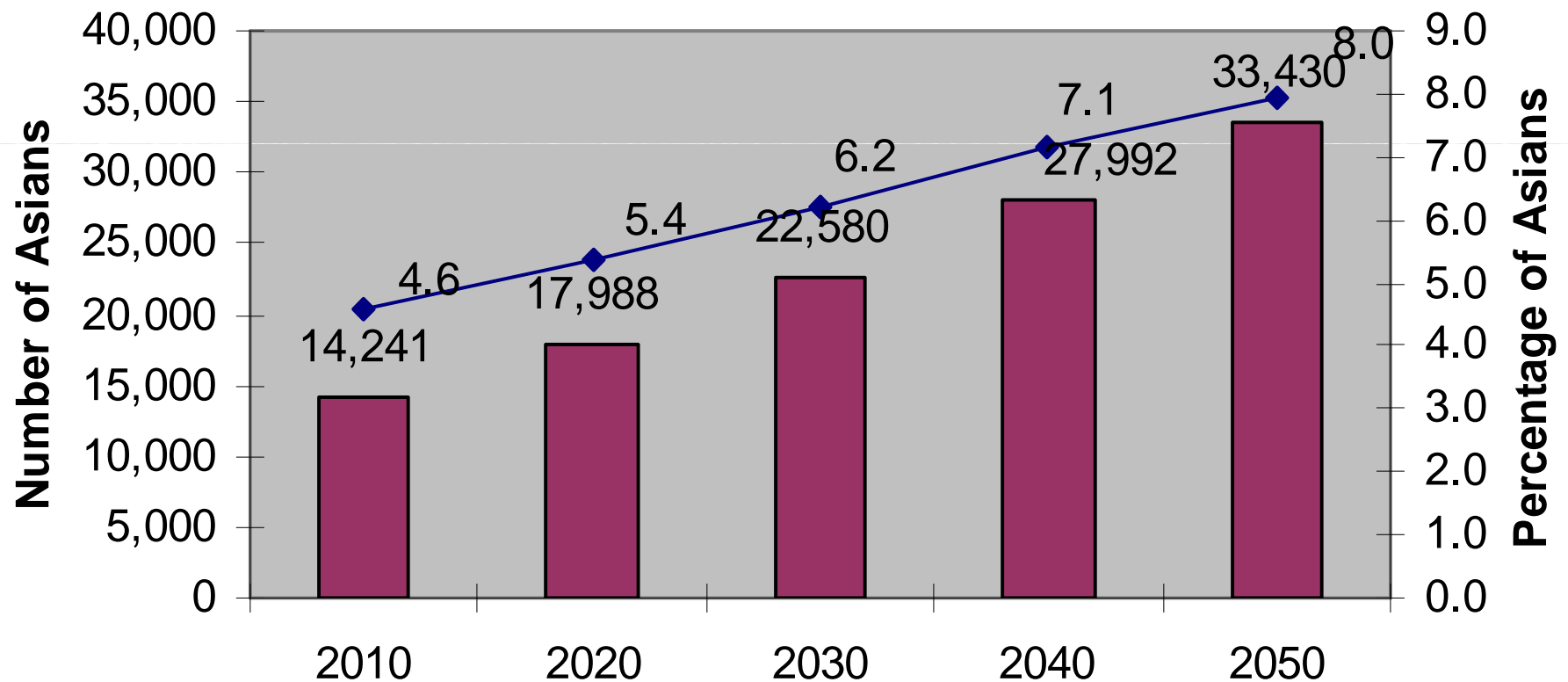

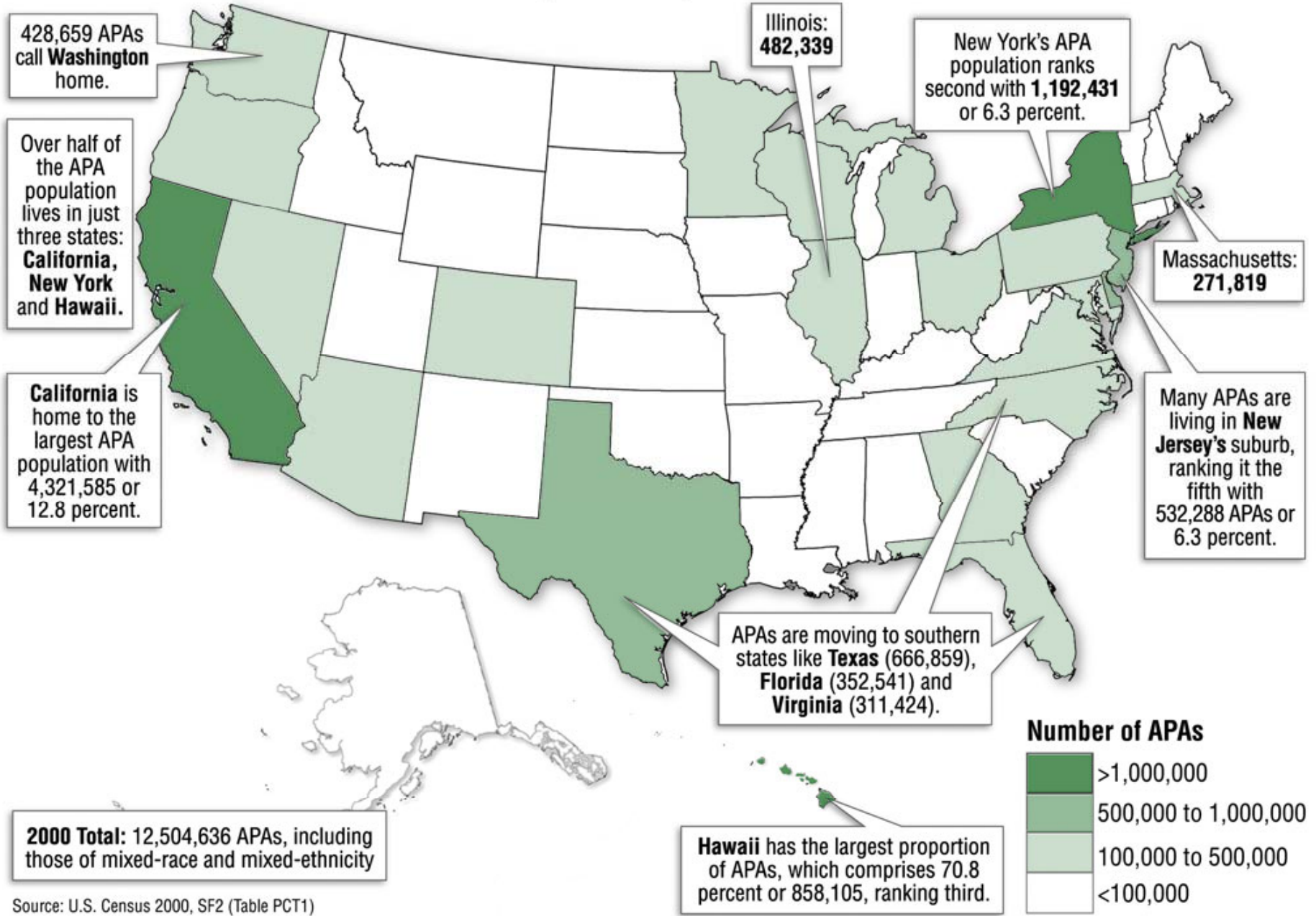

Boston's APA community is third-largest with 48,941 or 8.3 percent.

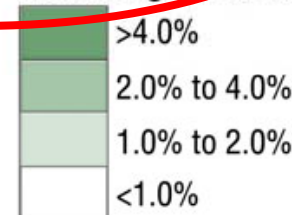
Quincy, MA: 14,006 APAs or 15.6 percent, ranking seventh.

Providence, Rhode Island: 12,793 APAs, ranking ninth

New York City has the largest number of APAs (888,637) on the Northeast, surpassing all other cities eight-fold.

APAs in **Jersey City** (42,773), **Edison** (29,539) and **Fort Lee** (11,489) represent New Jersey among the top 10 APA communities.

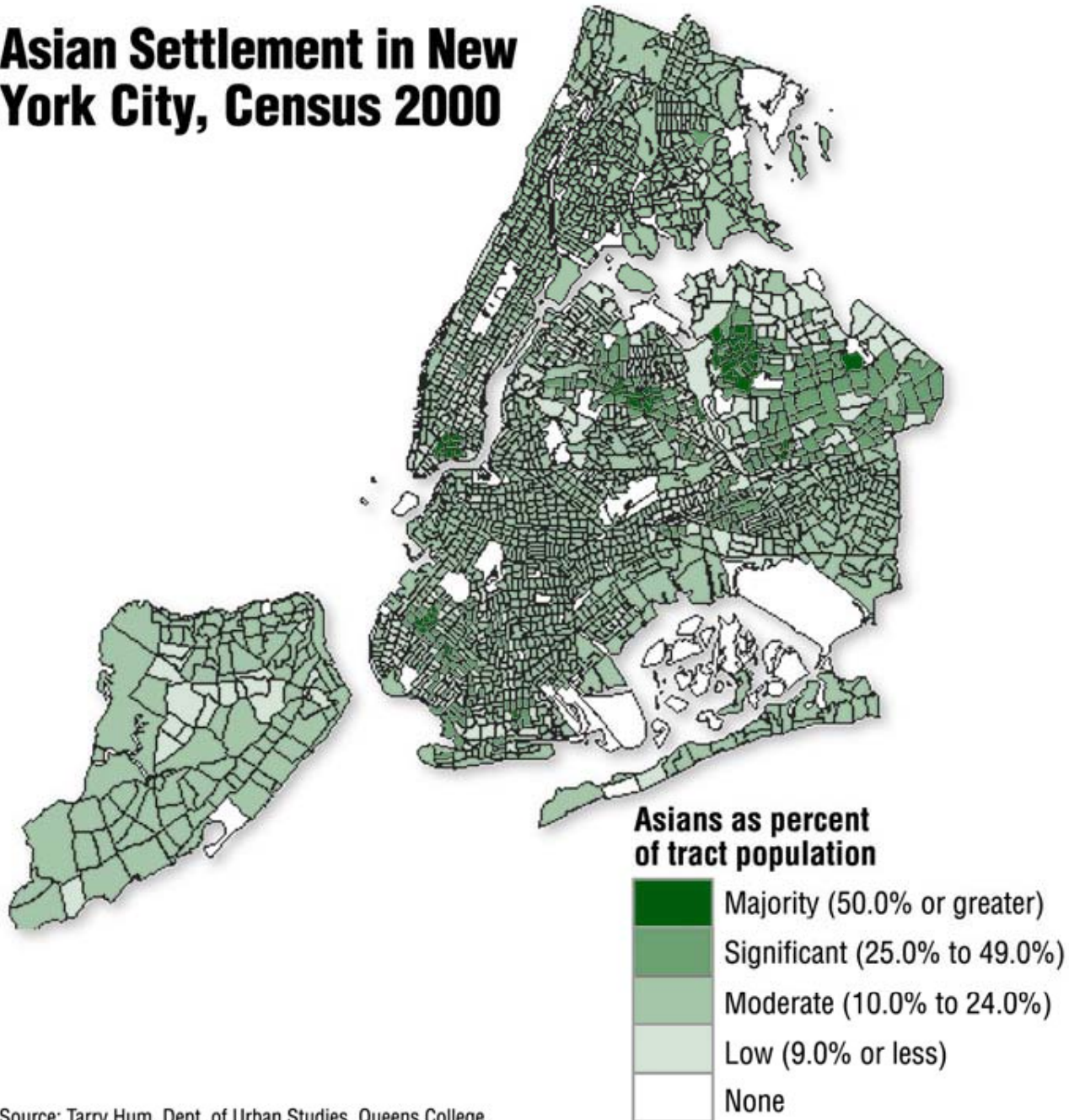
Percentage of APAs

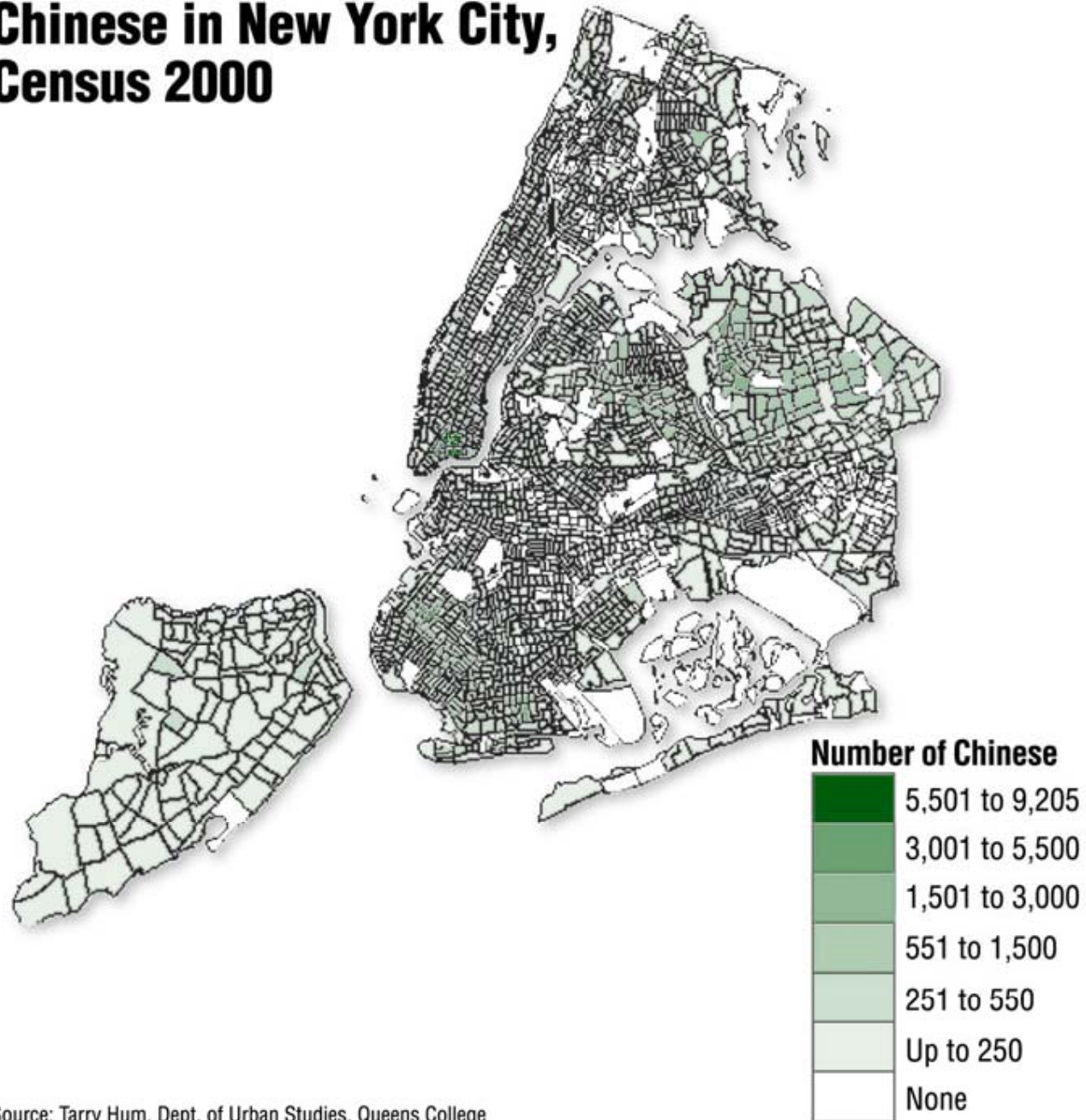

Asian Settlement in New York City, Census 2000



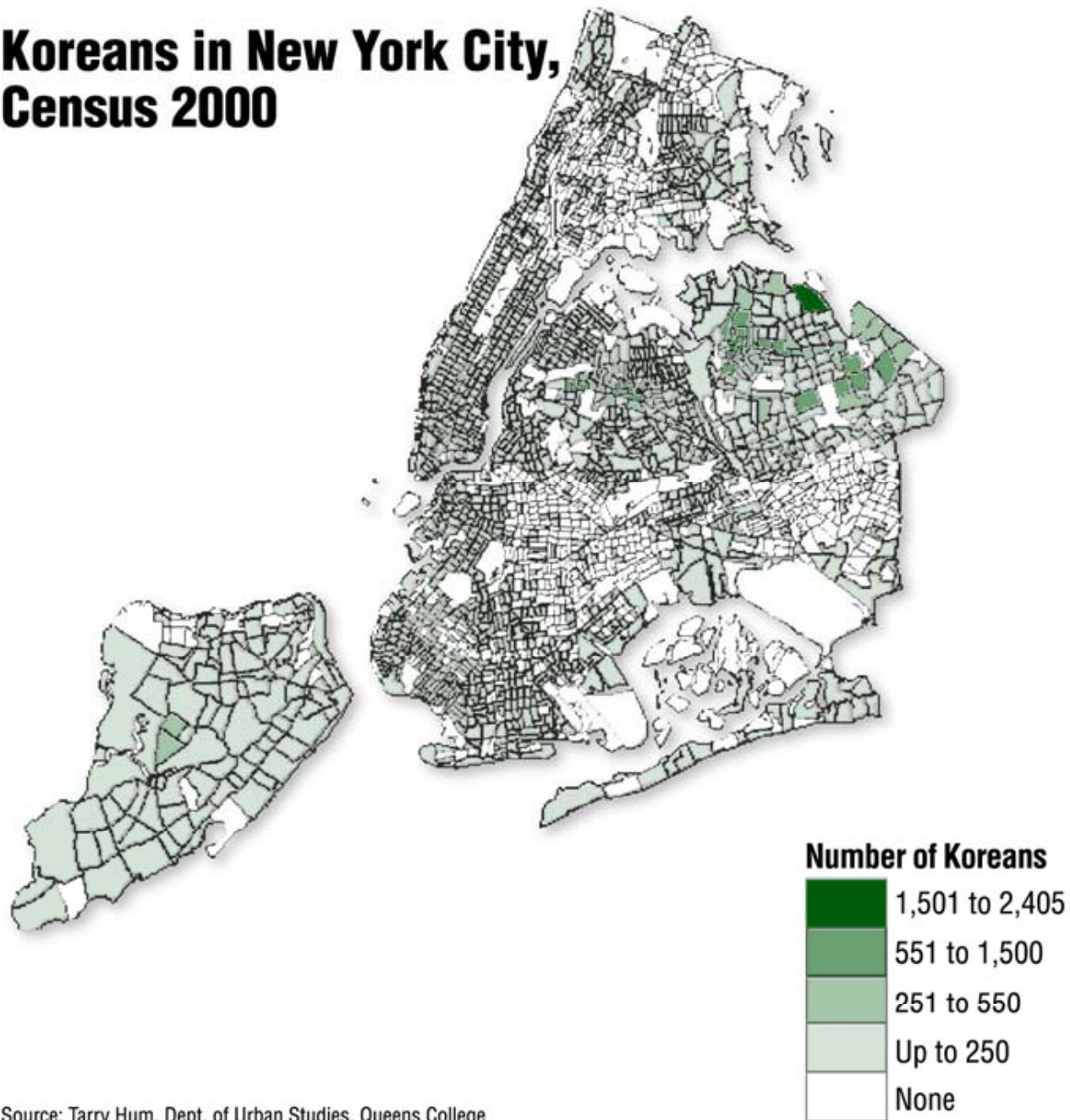

Chinese in New York City, Census 2000



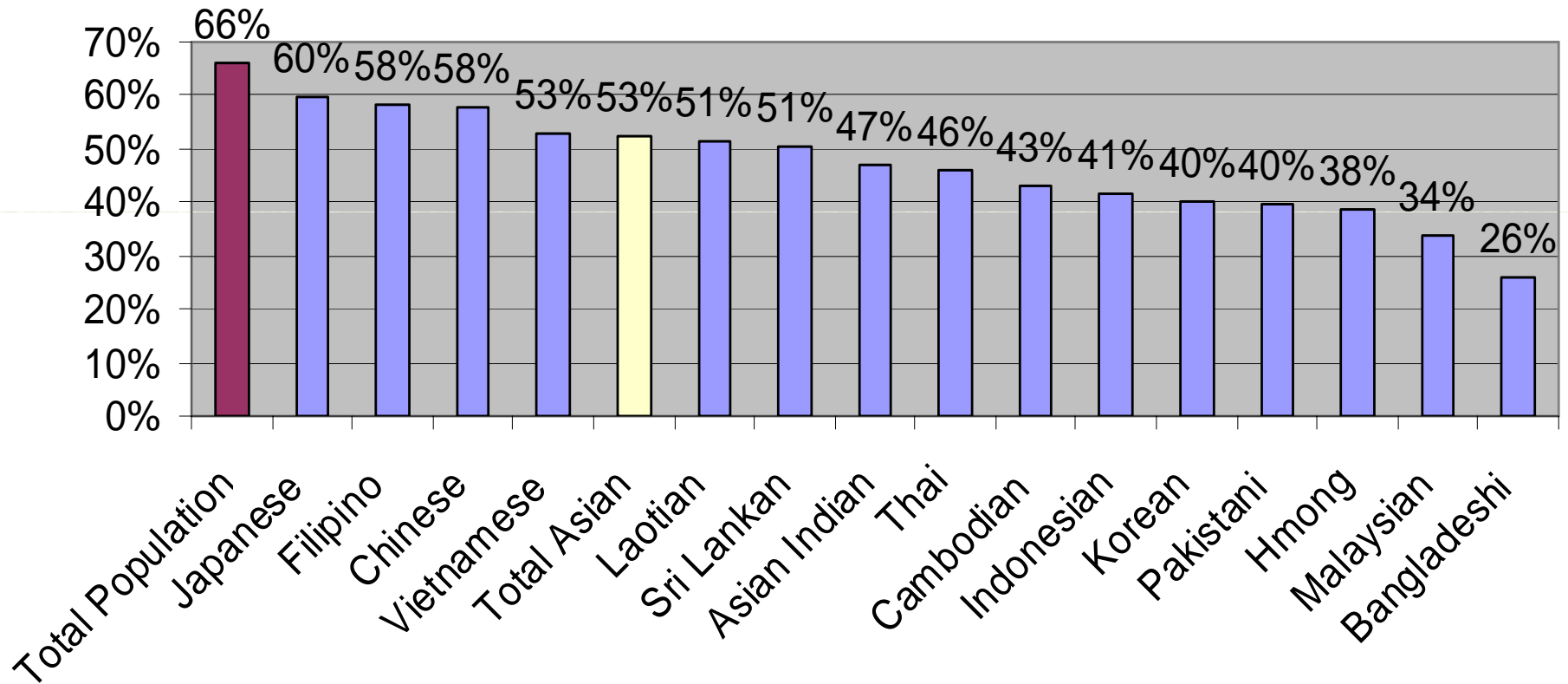

Koreans in New York City, Census 2000



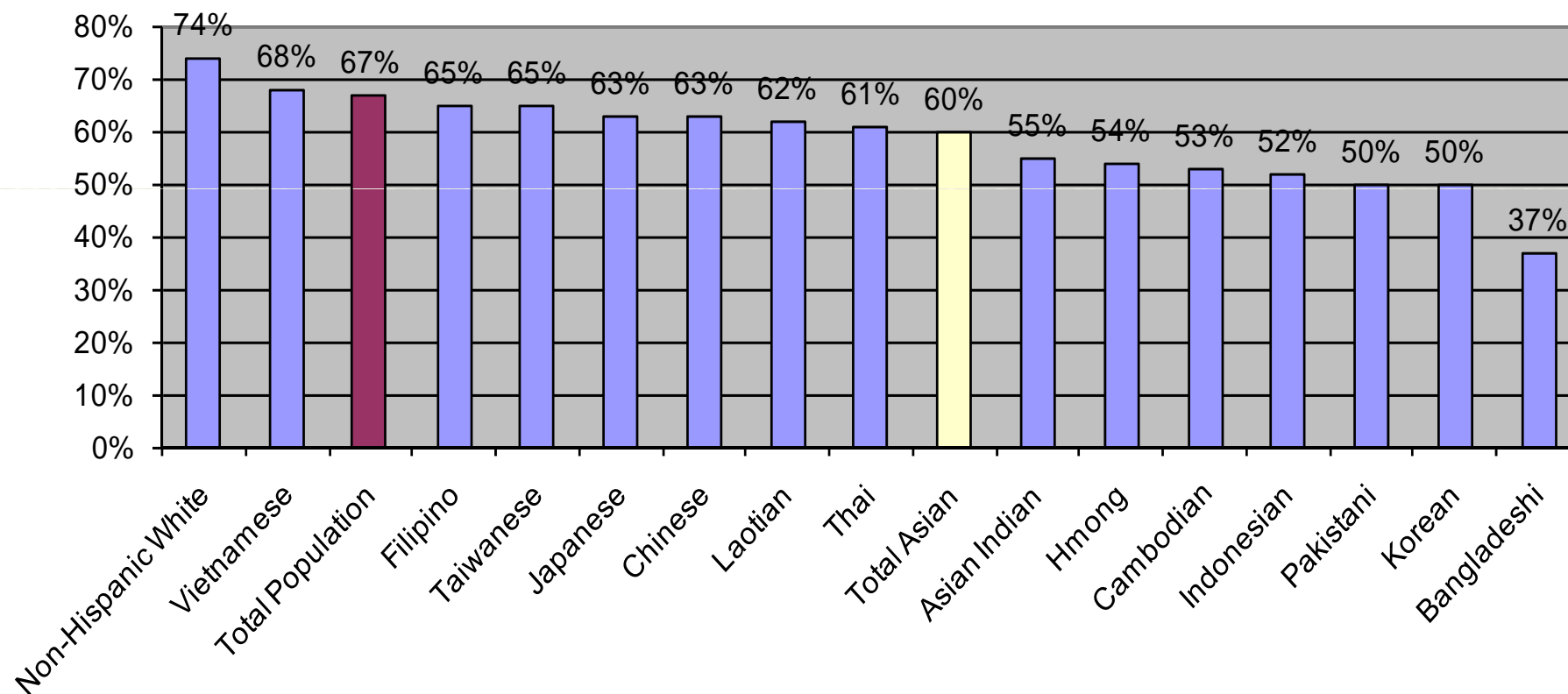

2000 National Homeownership Rates



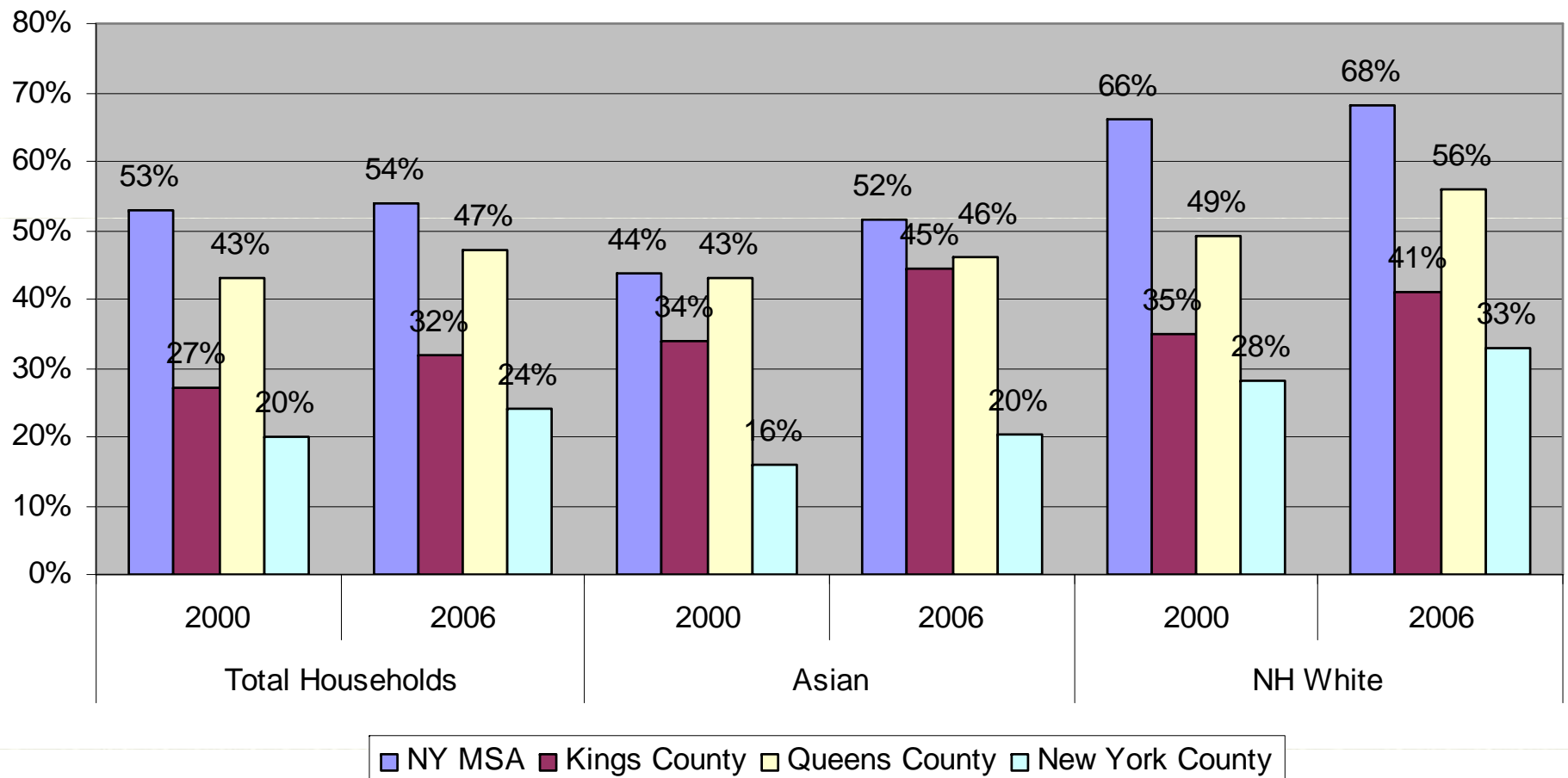
